

SCHOOL DAYS ON



You've been asked to create a **School Days** comic strip.
How **creative** can you get?!

Basic Instructions:

1. You are going to be using the **Comic Life** app on the **iPad**. You've already played with the app before so it shouldn't be too unfamiliar.
2. Use one iPad per group, you need to work in **groups of 2 or 3**.
3. Create a comic strip telling a short **School Days** story. The story must take place here at our **Elkanah SP** and you'll be using **photos** not images from Google.
4. The comic should consist of **at least 6 pages** but not more than 10 pages. Be sure to give your comic **a great title and include your names** on the front cover!
5. Before you and your partner begin, you need to plan your story line first. Who are the characters? What is going to happen? How will it end? It can even be based on reality!
6. Take a look at **the rubric**. This will be very helpful in knowing what we are expecting from you. Remember it's a written task so be sure to include enough writing!
